Cash Position provides a quick up-to-the minute overview of your Huntington accounts.

Cash Flow Forecast helps you identify typical ebbs and flows in your accounts.

Dashboard View

Get a fast view anytime, anywhere of available cash assets, including beginning balance, and recently posted deposits and debits. View one or more of your cash accounts, or view them all. Dig right into the cash flow view, too, with just a click.

Detail View


Track available cash balances and cash reserves quickly and easily, so you can project profitability and foresee potential problems. View any or all of your cash accounts. Pick a pre-determined date range for a visual view of where your cash has been and where it's going. Plus, see a list of related transactions for the selected range.




Cash Position & Cash Flow Forecast

BUSINESS

Cash Position Overview

Get a top-line view of your money so you know where you stand.



ACCOUNTS:

Examine one or more of your Huntington accounts – checking, savings and money market accounts.

BEGINNING BALANCE:

See your cash balances at the start of the business day.

CREDITS:

Balance of current deposits since end-of-day processing.

DEPOSIT HOLDS:

Balance of current deposits on hold.

DEBITS

Balance of current debits since end-of-day posting.


CASH BALANCE:

See what's on hand in near real-time.

Note: To refresh, just log out and log in again.

Cash Flow Forecast Overview

See, manage and forecast your cash-ins and cash-outs over time.



TRANSACTION TYPES:

See your money in and money out, including checks, deposits, debits, electronic funds transfer (EFT) and wire transfers

ACCOUNTS:

Choose one or more cash accounts to view.

DATE RANGE:

Pick a rolling 30- or 90-day period, or a 6- or 12-month view.


BAR GRAPH:

Dark gray shows today's balance. Light gray signifies balances over the past 15 days. Gold denotes anticipated balances 15 days ahead. Red triangles are early indicators of possible shortfalls.

Note: Anticipated balances are based on scheduled bills pays, transfers, payment patterns and income patterns that you input. The more patterns you add, the better your Cash Flow Forecast becomes. Just head to Look Ahead Calendar to enter patterns.

Setting the Cash Reserve

Set your minimum desired account balance and begin tracking and forecasting your monthly spend against this baseline.

- 2 The bar graph will adjust to the new Cash Reserve.
